

## AP Calculus Study Log Requirements

Part of your grade for the last 6 weeks will be based on the time you spend studying for the AP test on

# MAY 5<sup>th</sup>.

You will be required to turn in a log of how much time you spend studying for the AP test. Your logs will need to include:

1. The day and time interval
2. Who you studied with (if you studied with someone.)
3. The topic you studied
4. What materials you used (internet videos, practice test book, class handouts, old tests, etc.)
5. What you learned while you were studying and what questions you have?
6. A running total for time spent on calculus outside of class.

This is due as you walk into class on May 4<sup>th</sup>. After that it will be considered late and will not receive full credit. (If you are not in class on May 4<sup>th</sup>, you need to get your log to me before class starts.)

With your log you need to turn in:

- A completed KNL chart
- Problems you worked while studying
- Summaries of videos you watched while studying

Your grade will be based on the total time you spend outside of class and the descriptions/completeness of your logs and supporting work.

- You need to study at least 10.5 hours outside of class over the next two weeks (approximately 45 minutes a day).
- 1 in-person session on Saturday counts as 90 minutes
- Use your KNL chart to help you pick topics to study.
